DIY Laundry Soap

Ingredients & Supplies:

- 1/3 Bar of soap grated (appx. 52g or 1.8 oz) (Fels-Naptha or whatever scent is preferred)
- 1/2 cup Washing soda
- 1/2 cup Borax
- Water
- · Cheese grater
- 5-gallon bucket
- Large stock pot



Directions:

- Grate bar of soap directly into a large cooking pot, then pour in 6 cups water. You can rinse the grater in the water, as to not waste any soap.
- 2. Heat over medium heat until the soap is dissolved.
- Add in the Washing Soda and Borax and stir until soap is dissolved. Remove from heat.
- 4. Take your 5-gallon bucket and pour 4 cups hot water into it. Then pour in soap mixture and stir. Now add one gallon and 6 cups water and stir.
- 5. Let the soap sit for about 24 hours and it should congeal and be ready for use. Use ½ cup per load.
