PVC DIDGERIDOO



Supplies

- 5-6 feet of 1 ½ inch PVC (or adjust diameter to fit your mouth)
- (1) 1 ½ inch coupler piece
- (1) 1 ½ inch to 1 inch bushing

Optional

• Rust-oleum 2X spray paint (must bond to plas-

Directions

- Cut 5- 6 feet of the 1 ½ inch PVC. if the diameter is too big to form an airtight seal around your lips, then try going down ¼ of an inch at a time until you find a diameter that works best for you. The longer the PVC, the lower the tone of the didgeridoo. The shorter the tube, the higher the tone.
- 2. Remove any PVC dust from cutting with a razor, to create a clean edge.
- 3. Clean the PVC well and remove and dust or dirt.
- Let dry, then if desired, spray evenly with spray paint, you can spray the coupler and bushing pieces as well or leave them white. Allow adequate time for drying.
- 5. Once dry, you can paint over the primer with acrylics or add more layers of spray paint to personalize it further.
- 6. Slip the bushing into the coupler, and the coupler onto your PVC tube, and you are done!
