## DUCT TAPE WALLET



## **Supplies**

- 3 yards of duct tape
- Scissors
- Ruler

## Instructions

- 1. Make one sheet of double-sided layered fabric 10" x 10".
- 2. From this sheet cut the following:
  - a. One piece 9" x 3.5" (Large)
  - b. One piece 9" x 2.5" (Medium)
  - c. Two pieces 4.25" x 2" (Small)
- 3. Cut 2- 9" pieces and 2-4.25" pieces of tape. Seal one lengthwise side of each piece from Step 2.
- 4. Stack the Medium over the Large, sealed side up, lining up bottom, long edges and short sides.
- Stack each Small in the Right and Left lower corners, sealed side up. There will be a gap between the 2 Smalls in the center of the wallet.
- Cut 2- 3.5" pieces of tape. Place half of each of these lengthwise over each side edge, then fold to backside to secure side seams.
- 7. Cut 1-3" piece of tape. Place lengthwise, centered between 2 Smalls.
- 8. Cut 1-9" piece of tape. Place half lengthwise along bottom edge, then fold to backside to secure bottom seam.
- 9. Your wallet is now ready to load and use!

Optional: Add a bit of Velcro to secure wallet closure
