

# DIY LAUNDRY SOAP

## Ingredients & Supplies:

- 1/3 Bar of soap grated (appx. 52g or 1.8 oz) (Fels-Naptha or whatever scent is preferred)
- 1/2 cup Washing soda
- 1/2 cup Borax
- Water
- Cheese grater
- 5-gallon bucket
- Large stock pot



## Directions:

1. Grate bar of soap directly into a large cooking pot, then pour in 6 cups water. You can rinse the grater in the water, as to not waste any soap.
2. Heat over medium heat until the soap is dissolved.
3. Add in the Washing Soda and Borax and stir until soap is dissolved. Remove from heat.
4. Take your 5-gallon bucket and pour 4 cups hot water into it. Then pour in soap mixture and stir. Now add one gallon and 6 cups water and stir.
5. Let the soap sit for about 24 hours and it should congeal and be ready for use. Use 1/2 cup per load.
