

MASON JAR SNOW GLOBE

Supplies:

- E6000 All Purpose Craft Glue
- Mason jar and lid (single-piece lid, not two-piece)
- Figurines / toys
- Glycerine
- Glitter and/or hole punched paper
- Vinegar or tea tree oil (optional)



Directions:

1. Being careful not to over apply, use E6000 glue to adhere figurines to the inside lid of mason jar. (It is easier to use the brass-colored, one-piece mason jar lids rather than the traditional two-piece.)
2. Allow glue to fully dry. In the meantime, fill mason jar almost full with water, add a dash of glycerine (count to two while you pour). Add in glitter and/or hole-punched paper pieces. You can add a cap-full of White Vinegar or a few drops of tea tree oil to the mixture to prevent mold and make your snow globe last longer.
3. Once figurine is completely dry, apply glue to the grooves on the top of mason jar, slowly submerge figure in the water and screw cap closed. Some overflow water might spill out as you close the lid, so just be careful. Allow globe to sit with lid facing up while seal is drying.
4. After glue around the lid dries, flip it over and you're done!



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
